



In March of 2022, our Center became a Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinic (CCBHC).



San Angelo Clubhouse was reaccredited by Clubhouse International for three years in April 2022.



In August 2022, MHMRCV hosted a Sequential Intercept Model Mapping (SIM) of Tom Green County, where 30 individuals from various organizations participated. SIM is the process of mapping how individuals with unmet BH needs interact with and move through the criminal justice system.
